

CLEANING & SANITIZING HARDSURFACES

1. Clean with hot soapy water.
2. Rinse with clean, hot water.
3. Sanitize with bleach solution.

Chlorine Bleach Sanitizing Solution

One teaspoon of bleach to a gallon of water; use a cloth or spray bottle to apply this to surfaces and let air dry. (For a larger supply of disinfectant, add $\frac{1}{4}$ cup of bleach to a gallon [16 cups] of water.) NOTE: More bleach is not better.

4. Air-dry only. Do not cloth-dry.

Toys can be soaked in bleach solution of $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon per gallon of water for at least one minute, and then drained and allowed to air dry.
